Coach Mike was a four year member and played NCAA Div. 3 College Hockey for Potsdam State University, where he captained the team in his senior season. Coach Mike also played semi-professional hockey for the Frederick Freeze and the York Ice-Cats in the NEHL.

Coach Mike started his coaching career at Potsdam State as an Assistant Coach, where he stayed for three years. As well, Coach Mike's 23-year coaching career has taken him to the New York State High School, Midget AAA, AA and Junior B levels. Coach Mike has also coached several NYS District Select 15, 16, and 17 teams. He worked in player development for the NYS District for 12 years, coaching NHL players Brian Gionta, Dustin Brown, Jimmy Howard, Marty Reasoner, Robert Esche, and Tim Connelly, as well as several NCAA Div. I & 3, Major Junior, and Tier II Junior players. Coach Mike has worked numerous Hockey School's, Potsdam State, Huron, and Howie Meeker Hockey Schools.
